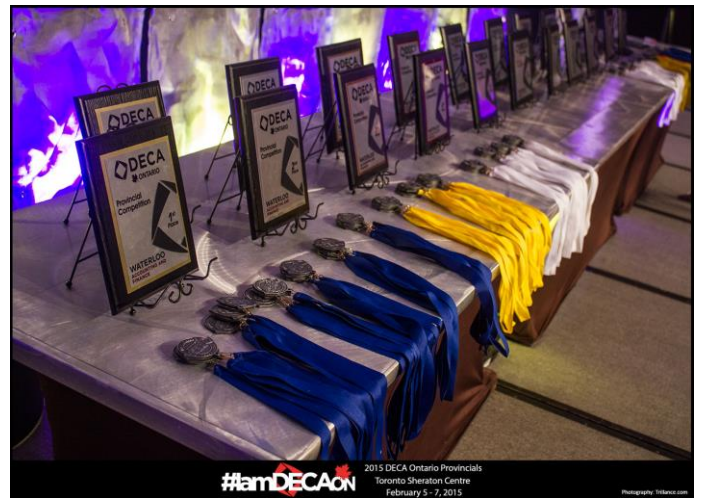


FUN FACTS

Key Facts:

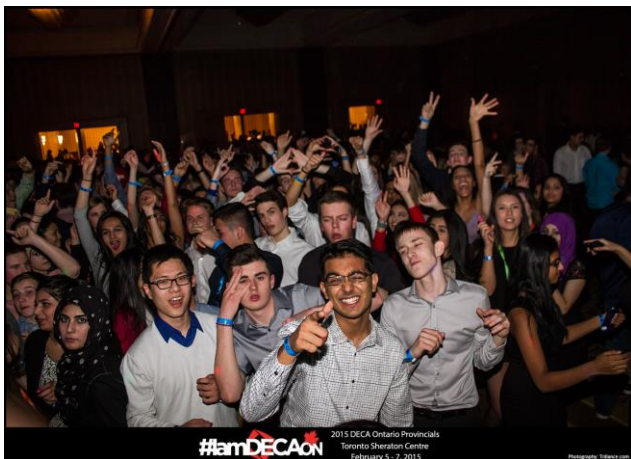
- 11,500 + members across over 250 high schools in Ontario

September 26, 2016: Fall Symposium at Capitol Banquet Hall, 6435 Dixie Road

- Initial training by professional speakers and Provincial Student Executive Team on high school chapter management
- Attended by entire Provincial Student Executive Team and 600 - 700 high school DECA chapter executives

November 2016: Six area regionals taking place across the province

- Between 1 000 and 2100 students participating per regional competition; over 120 teachers at each event
